A BILL

To provide that certain project works on the St. Croix River, Maine, are not required to be licensed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL POWER ACT LICENSE NOT REQUIRED**
4 **FOR CERTAIN PROJECT WORKS ON THE ST.**
5 **CROIX RIVER, MAINE.**

6 Any project works in existence as of the date of enact-
7 ment of this Act, or as may later be modified, that are
8 licensed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
9 under Commission Project numbers 2492, 2618, and
10 2660, as in effect on such date of enactment, shall not

1 be required to be licensed under part I of the Federal
2 Power Act (16 U.S.C. 792 et seq.).

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
