## A BILL

To limit the United States from rejoining the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Iran Nuclear
- 5 Verification Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON UNITED STATES FROM REJOINING
- 7 THE JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF AC-
- 8 TION.
- 9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 10 sion of law, the United States may not become a party

- 1 to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action or to any other
- 2 agreement with Iran relating to the nuclear program of
- 3 Iran until the President certifies to Congress that nuclear
- 4 inspectors of the United Nations—
- 5 (1) are allowed full access to all of Iran's nu-
- 6 clear facilities; and
- 7 (2) have completed their comprehensive report 8 relating to Iran's nuclear facilities.
- 9 (b) Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action De-
- 10 FINED.—In this section, the term "Joint Comprehensive
- 11 Plan of Action" means the Joint Comprehensive Plan of
- 12 Action signed at Vienna on July 14, 2015, by Iran and
- 13 by France, Germany, the Russian Federation, the People's
- 14 Republic of China, the United Kingdom, and the United
- 15 States, and all implementing materials and agreements re-
- 16 lated to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action.
