A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Labor and Employment – Minimum Wage – Allegany County and Garrett County**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a minimum wage rate for Allegany County and Garrett
4 County; making conforming changes; and generally relating to the payment of wages
5 in Allegany County and Garrett County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Labor and Employment**

14 3–413.

15 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

16 (2) “Employer” includes a governmental unit.

17 (3) “Small employer” means an employer that employs 14 or fewer
18 employees.

19 (b) Except as provided in subsection [(d)] **(E)** of this section and §§ 3–413.1 and
20 3–414 of this subtitle, each employer shall pay:

21 (1) to each employee who is subject to both the federal Act and this subtitle,

at least the greater of:

(i) the minimum wage for that employee under the federal Act; or

(ii) the State minimum wage set under subsection (c) of this section;

and

(2) to each other employee who is subject to this subtitle, at least the greater of:

(i) the highest minimum wage under the federal Act; or

(ii) **1. FOR A COUNTY OTHER THAN ALLEGANY COUNTY OR GARRETT COUNTY, the State minimum wage set under subsection (c) of this section; OR**

2. FOR ALLEGANY COUNTY OR GARRETT COUNTY, THE MINIMUM WAGE SET UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.

(c) (1) Subject to § 3–413.1 of this subtitle and except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the State minimum wage rate is:

(i) for the 12–month period beginning July 1, 2017, \$9.25 per hour;

(ii) for the 18–month period beginning July 1, 2018, \$10.10 per hour;

(iii) for the 12–month period beginning January 1, 2020, \$11.00 per hour;

(iv) for the 12–month period beginning January 1, 2021, \$11.75 per hour;

(v) for the 12–month period beginning January 1, 2022, \$12.50 per hour;

(vi) for the 12–month period beginning January 1, 2023, \$13.25 per hour;

(vii) for the 12–month period beginning January 1, 2024, \$14.00 per hour; and

(viii) beginning January 1, 2025, \$15.00 per hour.

(2) Subject to § 3–413.1 of this subtitle, the State minimum wage rate for a small employer is:

(i) for the 18–month period beginning July 1, 2018, \$10.10 per hour;

- 1 (ii) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2020, \$11.00 per
2 hour;
- 3 (iii) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2021, \$11.60 per
4 hour;
- 5 (iv) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2022, \$12.20 per
6 hour;
- 7 (v) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2023, \$12.80 per
8 hour;
- 9 (vi) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2024, \$13.40 per
10 hour;
- 11 (vii) for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2025, \$14.00 per
12 hour;
- 13 (viii) for the 6-month period beginning January 1, 2026, \$14.60 per
14 hour; and
- 15 (ix) beginning July 1, 2026, \$15.00 per hour.

16 (D) SUBJECT TO § 3-413.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE MINIMUM WAGE RATE IN
17 ALLEGANY COUNTY AND GARRETT COUNTY IS:

18 (1) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2021,
19 \$11.50 PER HOUR;

20 (2) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2022,
21 \$12.00 PER HOUR;

22 (3) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023,
23 \$12.50 PER HOUR;

24 (4) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2024,
25 \$13.00 PER HOUR;

26 (5) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025,
27 \$13.50 PER HOUR;

28 (6) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2026,
29 \$14.00 PER HOUR;

30 (7) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2027,

1 **\$14.50 PER HOUR; AND**

2 **(8) FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2028,**
3 **\$15.00 PER HOUR.**

4 **[(d)] (E)** An employer may pay an employee a wage that equals a rate of 85% of
5 the State minimum wage established under this section if the employee is under the age of
6 18 years.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2020.
