- 8 COMMITTEE THAT OBTAINED THE CONTRIBUTION UNTIL THE CONTRIBUTION IS
- 9 REPAID TO THE CONTRIBUTOR.
- 10 (2) (I) A PERSON MAKING INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES OR
- 11 ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATIONS WHO OBTAINS A DONATION IN VIOLATION OF
- 12 THIS SECTION SHALL RETURN THE DONATION TO THE DONOR IMMEDIATELY AFTER

- 25 (10) SOLICITING A RECURRING CONTRIBUTION OR DONATION 26 WITHOUT THE AFFIRMATIVE CONSENT OF THE CONTRIBUTOR OR DONOR AS
