A BILL

To reauthorize the Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Great Lakes Restora-
5 tion Initiative Act of 2025” or the “GLRI Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. GREAT LAKES RESTORATION INITIATIVE REAU-**
2 **THORIZATION.**

3 Section 118(c)(7)(J)(i) of the Federal Water Pollu-
4 tion Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1268(c)(7)(J)(i)) is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) in subclause (V), by striking “and” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in subclause (VI), by striking the period at
9 the end and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(VII) \$500,000,000 for each of
12 fiscal years 2027 through 2031.”.

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
