A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Buildings – Geothermal Energy Systems – Requirement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to install a geothermal energy system in certain
4 State buildings constructed by the State under certain circumstances; defining a
5 certain term; and generally relating to the use of geothermal energy systems in State
6 buildings.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

15 **4–410.1.**

16 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “STATE BUILDING” MEANS:**

17 **(1) A BUILDING CONSTRUCTED BY OR FOR THE STATE FOR**
18 **OCCUPANCY BY A STATE AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT; OR**

19 **(2) A BUILDING CONSTRUCTED FOR WHICH MORE THAN 50% OF THE**
20 **MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION CAME FROM STATE FUNDS.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(B) THE STATE SHALL INSTALL A GEOTHERMAL ENERGY SYSTEM IN EACH**
2 **STATE BUILDING CONSTRUCTED BY THE STATE IF THE PAYBACK PERIOD FOR THE**
3 **SYSTEM IS LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO 20 YEARS.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2021.
