9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 19-8-504, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"19-8-504. Employer's contribution. (1) The employer shall pay as employer contributions 9% of the
13	compensation paid to all of the employer's employees, except those properly excluded from membership.
14	(2) Subject to subsection (3), the employer shall contribute to the system an additional employer
15	$\underline{\text{contribution equal to 2\% of the compensation paid to all of the employer's employees}, except for those employees are the employees of the compensation paid to all of the employees of the employees.}$
16	properly excluded from membership.
17	(3) (a) The board shall periodically review the additional employer contribution provided for in subsection
18	(2) and recommend adjustments to the legislature as needed to maintain the amortization schedule set by the
19	board for payment of the system's unfunded liabilities.
20	(b) The employer contribution required under subsection (2) terminates on July 1 following the board's
21	receipt of the system's actuarial valuation if:
22	(i) the actuarial valuation determines that the period required to amortize the system's unfunded
23	liabilities, including adjustments made for any benefit enhancements enacted by the legislature THAT BECOME
24	EFFECTIVE after the valuation, is less than 25 years; and
25	(ii) terminating the additional employer contribution required under subsection (2) would not cause the
26	amortization period as of the most recent actuarial valuation to exceed 25 years.
27	(4) The department of fish, wildlife, and parks shall include in its budget and shall request for legislative
28	appropriation an amount necessary to defray the state's portion of the costs of this section."
