

- 1 (3)The Chesapeake Bay Trust may use the funds it receives under 2 this subsection only to provide grants and other resources to nonprofit organizations, 3 community associations, civic groups, schools, or public agencies for projects to enhance or 4 promote: 5 Public education, including the publication or production 1. 6 of educational materials, concerning the Chesapeake Bay, the Maryland coastal bays, the 7 Youghiogheny watershed, and other natural resources; 8 2. The preservation or enhancement of water quality and fish 9 or wildlife habitat; 10 3. The restoration of aquatic or land resources; 11 4. Reforestation; and 12 5. - 1 (2) May not be made available to an individual purchasing through an 2 authorized vendor; and
- 3 (3) Shall be limited to providing not more than two options to which an 4 individual may make a monetary donation.
- 5 [(g)] (H) The Department may adopt regulations to:
- 6 (1) Implement the electronic system authorized under this section; and
- 7 (2) Determine the appropriate fee levels that may be charged by a vendor 8 and by the Department for the electronic transmission service.

- 16 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 18 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 19 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 20 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 21 (1) DONATIONS COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER § 1–403(F) 22 OF THIS ARTICLE;
- 23 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND; 24 AND
- 25 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR 26 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
