A BILL

To authorize certain Federal departments to enter into contracts to carry out existing authorities to protect United States facilities from unmanned aircraft.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Enhanced Protection
- 5 from Unmanned Aircraft Attacks Act".

1	SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS TO PRO-
2	TECT FACILITIES FROM UNMANNED AIR
3	CRAFT.
4	(a) AUTHORITY.—The following Federal departments
5	are authorized to enter into contracts to carry out the fol-
6	lowing authorities:
7	(1) The Department of Defense for the purpose
8	of carrying out activities under section 130i of title
9	10, United States Code.
10	(2) The Department of Homeland Security for
11	the purpose of carrying out activities under section
12	210G of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6
13	U.S.C. 124n).
14	(3) The Department of Justice for the purpose
15	of carrying out activities under section 210G of the
16	Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 124n).
17	(4) The Department of Energy for the purpose
18	of carrying out activities under section 4510 of the
19	Atomic Energy Defense Act (50 U.S.C. 2661).
20	(b) Federal Acquisition Regulation.—Not later
21	than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act
22	the Federal Acquisition Regulatory Council shall amend
23	the Federal Acquisition Regulation to implement the au-
24	thority provided under subsection (a).
