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**A BILL**

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1  
4503.567 of the Revised Code to create the 2  
"Girls on the Run" license plate. 3

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That section 4501.21 be amended and section 4  
4503.567 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

**Sec. 4501.21.** (A) There is hereby created in the state 6  
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 7  
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 8  
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 9  
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 10  
4503.496, 4503.497, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.50, 4503.501, 11  
4503.502, 4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.514, 4503.521, 4503.522, 12  
4503.523, 4503.524, 4503.525, 4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 13  
4503.531, 4503.534, 4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 14  
4503.553, 4503.554, 4503.555, 4503.556, 4503.561, 4503.562, 15  
4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.567, 4503.576, 4503.577, 4503.591, 16  
4503.592, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 4503.701, 4503.702, 17  
4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 4503.72, 18

4503.722, 4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.733, 4503.74, 4503.75, 19  
4503.751, 4503.752, 4503.763, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.87, 20  
4503.871, 4503.874, 4503.877, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.901, 21  
4503.902, 4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, 4503.97, and 22  
4503.98 of the Revised Code. 23

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 24  
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 25

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 26  
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 27  
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 28  
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 29  
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 30  
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 31  
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 32  
other abortion-related activities. 33

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 34  
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 35  
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 36  
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 37  
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 38  
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 39  
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 40  
other money in that fund. 41

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 42  
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 43  
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 44  
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 45

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 46  
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 47

national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 48  
amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 49  
chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 50  
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 51  
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 52  
directly to their clients. 53

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 54  
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 55  
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 56  
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 57  
pancreatic cancer and their families. 58

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 59  
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 60  
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 61  
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 62  
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 63

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 64  
receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the 65  
St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for 66  
its research and other programs. 67

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 68  
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 69  
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 70  
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 71

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 72  
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 73  
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 74  
contributions for its research and other programs. 75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 76

receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 77  
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 78  
contributions into its general account to be used for 79  
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 80  
America foundation. 81

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 82  
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 83  
4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 84  
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 85  
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 86

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 87  
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 88  
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 89  
scholarships and other educational activities. 90

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 91  
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 92  
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 93  
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 94  
that organization. 95

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 96  
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 97  
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 98  
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 99  
section. A university or college that receives contributions 100  
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 101  
scholarship fund. 102

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 103  
receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 104  
university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 105

awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 106  
the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it 107  
receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program. 108  
The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the 109  
university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such 110  
funds as provided in this section. 111

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 112  
receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the 113  
Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying 114  
for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio 115  
cyclists of all ages. 116

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 117  
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 118  
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 119  
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 120  
of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 121  
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 122  
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 123

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 124  
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 125  
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 126  
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 127  
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 128

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 129  
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 130  
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 131  
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 132  
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 133

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 134

receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 135  
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 136  
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 137  
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 138  
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 139  
sponsors within this state. 140

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 141  
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 142  
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 143  
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 144  
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 145  
activities. 146

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 147  
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 148  
Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 149  
money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 150  
incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 151  
provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 152  
this state. 153

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 154  
receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 155  
Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 156  
receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 157  
to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 158  
to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 159  
their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 160  
research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 161  
the improvement of patient outcomes. 162

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 163  
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 164

thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 165  
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 166  
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 167  
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 168  
personnel, veterans, and their families. 169

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 170  
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 171  
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 172  
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 173  
families. 174

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 175  
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 176  
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 177  
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 178  
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 179  
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 180  
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 181  
destination. 182

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 183  
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 184  
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 185  
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 186  
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 187

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 188  
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 189  
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 190  
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 191  
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 192  
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 193  
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 194

cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 195  
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 196  
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 197  
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 198

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 199  
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 200  
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 201

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 202  
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 203  
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 204  
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 205  
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 206  
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 207  
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 208  
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 209  
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 210  
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 211  
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 212  
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 213  
under this section. 214

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 215  
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 216  
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 217  
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 218  
programs. 219

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 220  
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 221  
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 222  
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 223

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 224  
receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the 225  
Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple 226  
negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the 227  
contributions for charitable and educational purposes. 228

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 229  
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 230  
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 231  
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 232  
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 233  
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 234  
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 235  
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 236  
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 237  
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 238  
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 239  
such payments are to be made. 240

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 241  
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 242  
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 243  
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 244  
river watershed. 245

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 246  
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 247  
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 248  
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 249

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 250  
receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 251  
conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 252  
the money in support of the park. 253

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 254  
receives pursuant to section 4503.567 of the Revised Code to the 255  
girls on the run of Franklin county, inc., which shall use the 256  
contributions to support the activities of the organization. 257

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 258  
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 259  
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 260  
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 261  
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 262  
local beekeeping programs. 263

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 264  
receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 265  
national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 266  
contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 267  
legends to inspire future leaders. 268

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 269  
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 270  
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 271  
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 272  
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 273  
commission and that is participating in the license plate 274  
program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 275  
of the county of residence of an applicant. 276

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each 277  
contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of 278  
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates 279  
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is 280  
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 281  
(G) of that section. 282

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program, which shall use the contributions for the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the girl scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.702 of the Revised Code to the Ohio Association of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order

of the Elks of the World, which shall use the funds for 312  
charitable purposes. 313

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 314  
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 315  
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 316  
deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 317  
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 318

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 319  
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 320  
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 321  
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 322  
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 323  
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 324  
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 325

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 326  
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 327  
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 328  
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 329  
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 330  
in the line of duty. 331

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 332  
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 333  
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 334  
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 335  
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 336

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 337  
receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 338  
fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 339  
to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 340

families. 341

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 342  
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 343  
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 344  
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 345  
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 346  
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 347  
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 348  
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 349  
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 350  
participating in that program. 351

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 352  
receives pursuant to section 4503.722 of the Revised Code to the 353  
Down Syndrome Association of Central Ohio, which shall use the 354  
contributions for advocacy purposes throughout the state. 355

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 356  
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 357  
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 358  
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 359  
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 360

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 361  
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 362  
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 363  
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 364  
Cleveland, Ohio. 365

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 366  
receives pursuant to section 4503.733 of the Revised Code to the 367  
Ohio chapter of the juvenile diabetes research foundation in 368  
whose geographic territory the person who paid the contribution 369

resides. 370

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 371  
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 372  
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 373  
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 374  
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 375  
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 376

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 377  
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 378  
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 379  
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 380  
used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 381  
rotary foundation. 382

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 383  
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 384  
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 385  
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 386  
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 387

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 388  
receives pursuant to section 4503.752 of the Revised Code to 389  
buckeye corvettes, incorporated, which shall use the 390  
contributions to pay for its charitable activities and programs. 391

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 392  
receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 393  
Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 394  
maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 395  
connection. 396

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 397  
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 398

Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 399  
research projects. 400

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 401  
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 402  
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 403  
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 404  
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 405  
state. 406

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 407  
receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 408  
Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 409  
contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 410  
baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 411

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 412  
receives pursuant to section 4503.871 of the Revised Code to the 413  
Solon city school district. The school district shall use the 414  
contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in 415  
providing services to the school district's students that assist 416  
in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being 417  
of the students. The services provided may include bereavement 418  
counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, 419  
sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of 420  
students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, 421  
suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district 422  
superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's 423  
discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate 424  
school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations 425  
that the school district hires to provide those services. The 426  
school district also may use the contributions it receives to 427  
pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive 428

training in providing such services to the students of the 429  
school district. The school district shall ensure that any 430  
charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt 431  
from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the 432  
Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the 433  
contributions it receives for any other purpose. 434

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 435  
receives pursuant to section 4503.874 of the Revised Code to St. 436  
Edward high school located in the municipal corporation of 437  
Lakewood. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 438  
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 439  
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 440  
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 441  
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 442  
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 443  
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 444  
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 445  
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 446  
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 447  
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 448  
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 449  
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 450  
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 451  
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 452  
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 453  
organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 454  
subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 455  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 456  
purpose. 457

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 458  
receives pursuant to section 4503.877 of the Revised Code to the 459

Independence local school district. The school district shall 460  
use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs 461  
in providing services to the school district's students that 462  
assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional 463  
well-being of the students. The services provided may include 464  
bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 465  
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 466  
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 467  
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school 468  
district superintendent or, in the school district 469  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 470  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 471  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 472  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 473  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 474  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 475  
students of the school district. The school district shall 476  
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 477  
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 478  
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 479  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 480  
purpose. 481

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 482  
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 483  
American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 484  
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 485  
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 486  
programs on a statewide basis. 487

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 488  
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 489  
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 490

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.901 of the Revised Code to the Ohio association for pupil transportation, which shall use the money to support transportation programs, provide training to school transportation professionals, and support other initiatives for school transportation safety.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of providing such services, the school may pay for members of the faculty of the school to receive training in providing those services. The school principal or, in the school principal's discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable organization is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school shall not use the contributions it receives for any other purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the

Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school 522  
district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 523  
expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 524  
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 525  
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 526  
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 527  
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 528  
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 529  
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 530  
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 531  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 532  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 533  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 534  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 535  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 536  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 537  
students of the school district. The school district shall 538  
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 539  
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 540  
501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 541  
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 542

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 544  
receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the 545  
Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school 546  
district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the 547  
expenses it incurs in providing services to the school 548  
district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the 549  
mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services 550  
provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 551  
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 552

counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 553  
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 554  
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 555  
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 556  
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 557  
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 558  
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 559  
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 560  
district to receive training in providing such services to the 561

incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 572  
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 573  
financial need. 574

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 575  
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 576  
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 577  
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 578  
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 579  
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 580  
vocational school districts. 581

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 582

receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the 583  
friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money 584  
to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free 585  
emergency medical first response throughout Israel. 586

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 587  
receives pursuant to section 4503.98 of the Revised Code to the 588  
Westerville parks foundation to support the programs and 589  
activities of the foundation and its mission of pursuing the 590  
city of Westerville's vision of becoming "A City Within A Park." 591

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate 592  
contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than 593  
the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall 594  
distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this 595  
section the investment income the fund earned the previous 596  
calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an 597  
entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity 598  
received from the fund during the previous calendar year. 599

Sec. 4503.567. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger 600  
car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other 601  
vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles 602  
may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle 603  
and issuance of "Girls on the Run" license plates. The 604  
application may be combined with a request for a special 605  
reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the 606  
Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and 607  
compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this 608  
section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the 609  
appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "Girls on the Run" 610  
license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker 611  
alone when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code. 612

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily 613  
inscribed on the license plates, "Girls on the Run" license 614  
plates shall display an appropriate logo and words selected by 615  
representatives of the girls on the run of Franklin county, inc. 616  
and that are approved by the registrar. "Girls on the Run" 617  
license plates shall display county identification stickers that 618  
identify the county of registration as required under section 619  
4503.19 of the Revised Code. 620

(B) "Girls on the Run" license plates and a validation 621  
sticker, or validation sticker alone, shall be issued upon 622  
receipt of an application for registration of a motor vehicle 623  
under this section; payment of the regular license tax as 624  
prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any 625  
applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504. 626  
of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee prescribed by 627  
section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, an additional 628  
administrative fee of ten dollars, and a contribution as 629  
provided in division (C) (1) of this section; and compliance with 630  
all other applicable laws relating to the registration of motor 631  
vehicles. 632

(C) (1) For each application for registration and 633  
registration renewal notice the registrar receives under this 634  
section, the registrar shall collect a contribution of twenty 635  
dollars. The registrar shall deposit this contribution into the 636  
state treasury to the credit of the license plate contribution 637  
fund created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code. 638

(2) The registrar shall deposit the administrative fee of 639  
ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the bureau of 640  
motor vehicles for additional services required in the issuing 641  
of "Girls on the Run" license plates, into the state treasury to 642

the credit of the public safety - highway purposes fund created 643  
in section 4501.06 of the Revised Code. 644
