### A BILL

To require a new or updated Federal website that is intended for use by the public to be mobile friendly, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Connected Government Act". SEC. 2. FEDERAL WEBSITES REQUIRED TO BE MOBILE 7 FRIENDLY. (a) In General.—If, on or after the date that is 6 8 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, an agen-10 cy creates a website that is intended for use by the public or updates a website that is intended for use by the public, the agency shall ensure that the website is mobile friendly. 13 (b) OMB Report.—Not later than 18 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the 14 15 Office of Management and Budget, in consultation with the Administrator of General Services, shall make publicly available and submit to Congress a report that describes the implementation of the requirement described under sub-18 section (a) and assesses the compliance of each agency with 19 such requirement. 20 (c) Definitions.—In this section:
