A BILL

To amend the Federal Crop Insurance Act to eliminate premium subsidies for crop insurance for tobacco.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "End Subsidies for To-
- 5 bacco Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PAYMENT OF PORTION OF PRE-
- 7 MIUM BY CORPORATION FOR TOBACCO.
- 8 Section 508(e) of the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7
- 9 U.S.C. 1508(e)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 10 lowing:

1	"(9) Prohibition on payment of portion
2	OF PREMIUM BY CORPORATION FOR TOBACCO.—
3	"(A) In General.—Effective beginning
4	with the 2018 reinsurance year, notwith-
5	standing any other provision of this subtitle, the
6	Corporation shall not pay any portion of the
7	premium for a policy or plan of insurance for
8	tobacco under this subtitle.
9	"(B) Deficit reduction.—Any savings
10	realized as a result of subparagraph (A) shall
11	be deposited in the Treasury and used for Fed-
12	eral budget deficit reduction.".
