A BILL

To amend section 2108.34, to enact section 1
4501.027, and to repeal sections 4506.081, 2
4507.231, and 4507.501 of the Revised Code to 3
require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and each 4
Deputy Registrar to ask each person renewing a 5
motor vehicle registration if that person wants 6
to make a voluntary contribution to the Second 7
Chance Trust Fund. 8

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2108.34 be amended and section 9
4501.027 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 10

Sec. 2108.34. (A) There is hereby created in the state 11
treasury the second chance trust fund. The fund shall consist of 12
voluntary contributions deposited as provided in sections 13
4501.027 and 4503.721, ~~4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ of the 14
Revised Code. All investment earnings of the fund shall be 15
credited to the fund. 16

(B) The director of health shall use the money in the fund 17

only for the following purposes: 18

(1) Development and implementation of a campaign that 19
explains and promotes the second chance trust fund; 20

(2) Development and implementation of local and statewide 21
public education programs about organ, tissue, and eye donation, 22
including the informational material required to be provided 23
under ~~sections 4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ section 4501.027 24
of the Revised Code; 25

(3) Development and implementation of local and statewide 26
donor awareness programs in schools; 27

(4) Development and implementation of local and statewide 28
programs to recognize donor families; 29

(5) Development and distribution of materials promoting 30
organ, tissue, and eye donation; 31

(6) Cooperation with the Ohio Supreme Court, Ohio State 32
Bar Association, and law schools of this state to more 33
effectively educate attorneys about the donation of anatomical 34
gifts and to encourage them to assist their clients in donating 35
anatomical gifts through anatomical gift declarations, durable 36
powers of attorney for health care, declarations as defined in 37
section 2133.01 of the Revised Code, wills, and any other 38
appropriate means; 39

(7) Cooperation with the state medical board, state 40
medical, osteopathic, and ophthalmological associations, and 41
colleges of medicine and osteopathic medicine in this state to 42
more effectively educate physicians about the donation of 43
anatomical gifts and to encourage them to assist their patients 44
in making declarations of anatomical gifts; 45

(8) Development of statewide hospital training programs to 46
encourage and facilitate compliance with sections 2108.14 and 47
2108.15 of the Revised Code; 48

(9) Reimbursement of the bureau of motor vehicles for the 49
administrative costs incurred in the performance of duties under 50
~~sections 4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501~~ section 4501.027 of 51
the Revised Code; 52

(10) Reimbursement of the department of health for 53
administrative costs incurred in the performance of duties under 54
this section and section 2108.35 of the Revised Code; 55

(11) Reimbursement of members of the second chance fund 56
advisory committee for actual and necessary expenses incurred in 57
the performance of official duties. 58

(C) The director shall make the materials developed under 59
division (B) (5) of this section available to other state 60
agencies. 61

(D) The director shall consider recommendations made by 62
the second chance trust fund advisory committee pursuant to 63
section 2108.35 of the Revised Code. The director shall 64
determine the appropriateness of and approve or disapprove 65
projects recommended by the advisory committee for funding and 66
approve or disapprove the disbursement of money from the second 67
chance trust fund. 68

Sec. 4501.027. (A) The registrar or deputy registrar of 69
motor vehicles shall ask whether each of the following wish to 70
make a one-dollar voluntary contribution to the second chance 71
trust fund established under section 2108.34 of the Revised 72
Code: 73

(1) A person applying for or renewing a driver's license, 74

motorcycle operator's endorsement, or duplicate; 75

(2) A person applying for an identification card or 76
duplicate under section 4507.51 of the Revised Code; 77

(3) A person applying for or renewing a commercial 78
driver's license, restricted commercial driver's license, or 79
duplicate; 80

(4) A person renewing a motor vehicle registration. 81

(B) The registrar or deputy registrar also shall make 82
available to the person informational material provided by the 83
department of health on the importance of organ, tissue, and eye 84
donation. 85

(C) All donations collected under this section during each 86
month shall be forwarded by the registrar or deputy registrar 87
not later than the fifth day of the immediately following month 88
to the treasurer of state, who shall deposit them in the second 89
chance fund. 90

Section 2. That existing section 2108.34 and sections 91
4506.081, 4507.231, and 4507.501 of the Revised Code are hereby 92
repealed. 93
