2 **State Highway Administration – Electronic Signs Along Highways – Suicide**
3 **Prevention**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Highway Administration to post information on
5 suicide prevention, including a hotline number, on electronic signs along any
6 highway within a certain radius of a high suicide risk zone, as identified by the
7 Administration; authorizing the Administration to adopt certain regulations; and
8 generally relating to suicide prevention and electronic signs along highways.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Transportation**

17 **8–662.**

18 **(A) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY POST INFORMATION ON SUICIDE**
19 **PREVENTION, INCLUDING A HOTLINE NUMBER, ON ELECTRONIC SIGNS ALONG ANY**
