- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Labor and Employment
- 15 **3–718**.
- 16 (A) AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE TO UNDERGO AN
- 17 ELECTIVE MEDICAL PROCEDURE UNLESS THE PROCEDURE WOULD HAVE A
- 18 SUBSTANTIAL EFFECT ON THE EMPLOYEE'S CAPACITY OR FITNESS TO PERFORM THE
- 19 **JOB PROPERLY.**
- 20 (B) AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT RETALIATE AGAINST AN EMPLOYEE WHO
- 21 DECLINES TO UNDERGO AN ELECTIVE MEDICAL PROCEDURE UNDER SUBSECTION
- 22 (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 2 $\,$ 1, 2022.
