 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Easy Enrollment Act
 - 5 of 2018".

1	SEC. 2. ALIGNING OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIODS FOR EX-
2	CHANGE PLANS WITH DEADLINE FOR FILING
3	FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURNS.
4	(a) In General.—Subparagraph (B) of section
5	1311(c)(6) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
6	Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(c)(6)) is amended to read as fol-
7	lows:
8	"(B) annual open enrollment periods—
9	"(i) for calendar years after the initial
10	enrollment period and before 2020, as de-
11	termined by the Secretary; and
12	"(ii) for 2020 and subsequent cal-
13	endar years, that begin on a date specified
14	by the Secretary and end on April 15 of
15	such calendar year;".
16	(b) Regulations.—Not later than 180 days after
17	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
18	Health and Human Services shall issue regulations to
19	carry out the amendment made by subsection (a).
