3 FOR the purpose of increasing the salaries of the Sheriff of Somerset County, the County
4 Commissioners of Somerset County, the President of the County Commissioners of
5 Somerset County, a member of the County Roads Board of Somerset County, and the
6 President of the County Roads Board of Somerset County; and generally relating to
7 the salaries of Somerset County public officials.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2–333.

(b) (1) The Sheriff of Somerset County shall receive an annual salary of not less than ~~[\$85,000]~~ **\$105,000**.

Article 20 – Somerset County

2–101.

(a) There are 5 County Commissioners for Somerset County, who hold office for 4 years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

(b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each Commissioner shall receive an annual salary of ~~[\$10,000]~~ **\$12,000**.

(2) The President of the County Commissioners shall receive an annual salary of ~~[\$11,000]~~ **\$13,000**.

9–104.

(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the members of the County Roads Board shall each receive, in addition to their compensation as County Commissioners, a salary of ~~[\$10,000]~~ **\$12,000** annually as a member of the County Roads Board.

(2) The President of the County Roads Board shall receive, in addition to compensation received as President of the County Commissioners, an annual salary of ~~[\$11,000]~~ **\$13,000**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in accordance with Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset County, the County Commissioners of Somerset County, the President of the County Commissioners of Somerset County, a member of the County Roads Board of Somerset County, or the President of the County Roads Board of Somerset County while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Somerset County, the County Commissioners of Somerset County, the President of the County Commissioners of Somerset County, a member of the County Roads Board of Somerset County, and the President of the County Roads Board of

1 Somerset County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This
2 limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of
3 this Act to fill out an unexpired term.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2025.
