A BILL

To amend section 742.07 of the Revised Code to
require the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund
Board of Trustees to elect a retirant member as
chairperson every third year.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 742.07 of the Revised Code be
amended to read as follows:

Sec. 742.07. Within three months after all of the first
appointed members of the board of trustees of the Ohio police
and fire pension fund have been appointed and qualified, the
governor shall call the first meeting of the board, and
thereafter meetings of the board shall be called in such manner
and at such times as the board prescribes, provided, that the
board shall meet at least four times annually. All meetings of
the board shall be open to the public except executive sessions
as set forth in division (G) of section 121.22 of the Revised
Code, and any portions of any sessions discussing medical
records or the degree of disability of a member excluded from
public inspection by section 742.41 of the Revised Code.

At its first meeting the board shall organize by electing 19
from its membership a chairperson and a vice-chairperson who 20
shall serve for a term of one year. Annually thereafter, the 21
board shall elect from ~~its membership~~ the members who are 22
employee members and retirant members a chairperson and a vice- 23
chairperson for a term of one year. At the first election for 24
chairperson that follows the effective date of this amendment, 25
and every third year thereafter, the members of the board shall 26
elect either the firefighter retirant member or the police 27
retirant member to serve as chairperson. 28

A majority of the full membership of the board shall 29
constitute a quorum. 30

Section 2. That existing section 742.07 of the Revised 31
Code is hereby repealed. 32
