2 Frederick County - County Employees and Volunteers - Criminal History Records Check

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of Human Resources of Frederick County to 4 5 request in a certain manner a State and national criminal history records check for 6 a prospective or current county employee or county volunteer; requiring the Central 7 Repository to forward certain information to certain persons; specifying that 8 information obtained from the Central Repository under this Act is confidential, may 9 not be redisseminated, and may be used only for certain purposes; authorizing the 10 subject of a criminal history records check to contest the contents of a certain 11 statement in a certain manner; and generally relating to criminal history records 12 checks for current or prospective county employees and county volunteers of 13 Frederick County.
