21	WHEREAS, In accordance with the Joint Chairmen's Report on the Operating					
22	Budget for fiscal 2023, the Maryland Department of Emergency Management submitted					
23	the Summary Report and Recommendations of the Task Force on Preventing and					
24	Countering Domestic Terrorism in December 2022; and					



- WHEREAS, The report of the Task Force on Preventing and Countering Domestic Terrorism made several recommendations following a series of meetings focused on how to deter domestic terrorism in Maryland; and
- WHEREAS, One of the recommendations from the report was to invest in a permanent State of Maryland capability focused on the prevention of violent extremist acts; and
- WHEREAS, In the United States, since the early 1980s, domestic terrorist attacks are occurring more frequently, and hate crimes, as reported to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, are the highest they have been in over a decade; now, therefore,
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13 14–101.
- 14 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 15 (b) "Department" means the Maryland Department of Emergency Management.
- 16 **14–104.3**.
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF DOMESTIC 18 TERRORISM RESPONSE.
- 19 **(B) (1)** THERE IS AN OFFICE OF DOMESTIC TERRORISM RESPONSE IN 20 THE DEPARTMENT.
- 21 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE OFFICE IS TO PREPARE FOR, PREVENT, 22 AND RECOVER FROM DOMESTIC TERRORISM AND HATE CRIMES.
- 23 (C) THE OFFICE SHALL COORDINATE WITH FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL AGENCIES IN DEVELOPING AND IMPLEMENTING PLANS TO:
- 25 (1) MAXIMIZE THE ROLE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION PLAY
  26 IN RESEARCHING AND DEVELOPING PROFESSIONAL TRAINING ON THE PREVENTION

- 3 (4) FACILITATE THE REHABILITATION AND REINTEGRATION OF 4 INDIVIDUALS WHO PARTICIPATE IN VIOLENT EXTREMISM.
- 5 (D) THE MARYLAND TASK FORCE ON PREVENTING AND COUNTERING 6 DOMESTIC TERRORISM SHALL SERVE IN AN ADVISORY ROLE FOR THE OFFICE.
- 7 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 8 REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE 9 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON:
- 10 (1) THE ACTIVITIES OF THE OFFICE;
- 11 (2) ANY RECOMMENDED LEGISLATION; AND
- 12 (3) ANY RESOURCES THAT THE OFFICE REQUIRES TO CARRY OUT ITS 13 PURPOSE AND DUTIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
