## Election Law – Persons Doing Public Business – Reporting by Governmental Entities

- FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that a governmental entity notify the State 4 5 Board of Elections if a person doing public business with the governmental entity 6 fails to file a statement under a certain provision of law; requiring a governmental 7 entity that has awarded a person a contract that causes the person to be doing public business to provide the State Board with certain information; authorizing the 8 9 governmental entity to comply with a certain provision of this Act by sending a 10 certain quarterly report to the State Board; requiring that the quarterly report 11 include the required information for certain persons and be submitted by a certain date; and generally relating to reporting by governmental entities of persons doing 12 13 public business.

  5 (i) require the person to certify that the person has filed the statement required under § 14-104(b)(1) of this title; and
- 7 (ii) [notify the State Board if a person doing public business with the 8 governmental entity fails to file the statement under § 14–104(b)(1) of this title] PROVIDE 9 THE STATE BOARD WITH THE PERSON'S NAME, ADDRESS, AND ANY OTHER CONTACT 10 INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE STATE BOARD.
- 11 (2) (I) A GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY MAY COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 12 (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY SENDING TO THE STATE BOARD A QUARTERLY 13 REPORT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE STATE BOARD.
- 14 (II) A QUARTERLY REPORT SENT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF
  15 THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR ANY PERSON

- 24 <u>BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE BOARD NO LATER</u> 25 THAN 10 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE CLOSE OF EACH CALENDAR QUARTER.
- 26 **[**(2)**] (3)** This subsection does not apply to a contract for which notice of award has been posted on eMaryland Marketplace.
- 28 (b) (1) If a person files a statement under § 14–104 of this title that does not 29 include all the information required, the State Board shall notify the person in writing of 30 the particular deficiencies.
- 31 (2) Within 30 days after service of the notice under paragraph (1) of this 32 subsection, the person shall file an amended statement that includes all the information 33 required.
