- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring businesses required to file a State sales and use tax return with the Comptroller to account for and pay, with the return, money not returned to 4 5 customers during a certain period due to a certain coin shortage, subject to certain exceptions; requiring the Comptroller to pay the money collected under this Act to 6

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- IN THIS SECTION, "NATIONAL COIN SHORTAGE" MEANS LOW COIN 18
- INVENTORIES DUE TO THE RAPID DECELERATION OF COIN CIRCULATION IN THE 19
- 20 SUPPLY CHAIN CAUSED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.
- 21 **(B) (1)** EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
- BUSINESS THAT IS REQUIRED TO FILE A SALES AND USE TAX RETURN WITH THE 22
- 23 COMPTROLLER UNDER TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE TAX - GENERAL ARTICLE

- 8 GIFT CARD OR REWARDS CARD; OR
- 9 2. THE CUSTOMER DONATES THE DIFFERENCE TO A
- 10 CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH STORE POLICY.
- 11 (C) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE MONEY COLLECTED
- 12 UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
