- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Tribal School Federal
- 5 Insurance Parity Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE INDIAN HEALTH CARE IM-
- 7 PROVEMENT ACT.
- 8 Section 409 of the Indian Health Care Improvement
- 9 Act (25 U.S.C. 1647b) is amended by inserting "or the
- 10 Tribally Controlled Schools Act of 1988 (25 U.S.C. 2501
- 11 et seq.)" after "(25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.)".
