A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Preserving Safety Net
- 5 Integrity Act of 2021".

1 SEC. 2. REQUIRING IMPLEMENTATION OF FINAL RULE.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
- 3 retary of Homeland Security may not take any action to
- 4 rescind, revise, or suspend the final rule, entitled "Inad-
