A BILL

To provide that all critical access hospitals are eligible for loans under the paycheck protection program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "PPP for Critical Ac-
- 5 cess Hospitals Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITALS IN
- 7 THE PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM.
- 8 Section 7(a)(36)(D) of the Small Business Act (15
- 9 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)(D)) is amended by adding at the end
- 10 the following:

1	"(vii) Inclusion of Critical Access
2	HOSPITALS.—During the covered period,
3	any nonprofit organization that is a critical
4	access hospital (as defined in section
5	1861(mm) of the Social Security Act (42
6	U.S.C. 1395x(mm))) shall be eligible to re-
7	ceive a covered loan, regardless of the sta-
8	tus of such a hospital as a debtor in a case
9	under chapter 11 of title 11, Unites States
10	Code, or the status of any debts owed by
1	such a hospital to the Federal Govern-
12	ment.".
