Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to increase MaineCare reimbursement for detoxification services. Resolved: That, no later than January 1, 2026, the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 97, Private Non-Medical Institution Services, Appendix B, Principles of Reimbursement for Substance Use Treatment Facilities, to reimburse for non-hospital-based medically supervised withdrawal services at no less than \$594.38 per day.
