Mrs. Ernst (for herself and Mrs. Gillibrand) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To require sexual assault prevention and response training for all individuals enlisted in the Armed Forces under a delayed entry program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Educating Service-
- 5 members in Training on Prevention Act" or "E-STOP
- 6 Act".

1	SEC. 2. SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND RESPONSE
2	TRAINING FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS ENLISTED
3	IN THE ARMED FORCES UNDER A DELAYED
4	ENTRY PROGRAM.
5	(a) Training Required.—Commencing not later
6	than January 1, 2018, each Secretary concerned shall pro-
7	vide training on sexual assault prevention and response
8	to each individual under the jurisdiction of such Secretary
9	who is enlisted in the Armed Forces under a delayed entry
10	program such that each such individual completes such
11	training before the date of commencement of basic train-
12	ing or initial active duty for training in the Armed Forces.
13	(b) Elements.—
14	(1) In general.—The training provided pur-
15	suant to subsection (a) shall meet such requirements
16	as the Secretary of Defense shall establish for pur-
17	poses of this section. Such training shall, to the ex-
18	tent practicable, be uniform across the Armed
19	Forces.
20	(2) Sense of congress on provision and
21	NATURE OF TRAINING.—It is the sense of Congress
22	that the training should—
23	(A) be provided through in-person instruc-
24	tion; and
25	(B) include instruction on the proper use
26	of social media.

1	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
2	(1) The term "delayed entry program" means
3	the following:
4	(A) The Future Soldiers Program of the
5	Army.
6	(B) The Delayed Entry Program of the
7	Navy and the Marine Corps.
8	(C) The program of the Air Force for the
9	delayed entry of enlistees into the Air Force.
10	(D) The program of the Coast Guard for
11	the delayed entry of enlistees into the Coast
12	Guard.
13	(E) Any successor program to a program
14	referred to in subparagraphs (A) through (D).
15	(2) The term "Secretary concerned" has the
16	meaning given that term in section 101(a)(9) of title
17	10, United States Code
