3 4 5 c. Participates in additional herd management requirements as specified by the Wildlife Resources Commission.

SECTION 2.(d) Additional Rulemaking Authority. – The Commission shall adopt

a rule to amend the Cervid Excretion Rule consistent with subsection (c) of this section. Notwithstanding G.S. 150B-19(4), the rule adopted by the Commission pursuant to this section shall be substantively identical to the provisions of subsection (c) of this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are not subject to Part 3 of Article 2A of Chapter 150B of the General Statutes. Rules adopted pursuant to this section shall become effective as provided in G.S. 150B-21.3(b1), as though 10 or more written objections had been received, as provided in G.S. 150B-21.3(b2).

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SECTION 2.(e) Applicability and Sunset. – This section and rules adopted pursuant to this section apply to any cervid excretions used for hunting on or after December 1, 2021. This section expires when permanent rules adopted as required by subsection (d) of this section become effective.

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SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
