A BILL

To direct the Joint Committee on the Library to obtain a statue of Shirley Chisholm for placement in the United States Capitol.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PLACEMENT OF STATUE OF SHIRLEY CHIS-
- 4 HOLM IN UNITED STATES CAPITOL.
- 5 (a) Obtaining Statue.—Not later than 5 years
- 6 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Joint Com-
- 7 mittee on the Library shall enter into an agreement to
- 8 obtain a statue of Shirley Chisholm, under such terms and

- 1 conditions as the Joint Committee considers appropriate
- 2 consistent with applicable law. The Joint Committee may
- 3 authorize the Architect of the Capitol to enter into the
- 4 agreement and related contracts required under this sub-
- 5 section on its behalf, under such terms and conditions as
- 6 the Joint Committee may require.
- 7 (b) Placement.—The Joint Committee on the Li-
- 8 brary shall place the statue obtained under subsection (a)
- 9 in a suitable permanent location in the United States Cap-
- 10 itol.
- 11 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
- 12 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
- 13 necessary to carry out this Act, and any amounts so ap-
- 14 propriated shall remain available until expended.
