SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF WAIVER OF LIMITATIONS WITH

RESPECT TO EXCLUDING FROM GROSS INCOME AMOUNTS RECEIVED BY WRONGFULLY

INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.
