a family of five trapped inside one of the burning units; with
the help of two Vestavia Hills firefighters, they cut a hole

in a masonry wall to rescue the trapped family o	of two adults
and three children; unfortunately, there were tw	o fatalities
during the apartment fire; and	

WHEREAS, placed in a life-threatening situation and without a moment's hesitation, Officers Corey Sarvaunt and Jonathan Mitchell placed themselves in the line of peril and saved many lives during a raging apartment fire; and
