An Act to require the publication of measures taken to restrict the access of obscene materials by minors.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 22-24-55 be AMENDED:

22-24-55. AnyEach public school that provides a public access computer in the state shall do one or both of the following:

- (1) Equip-the_each public access computer with software that will limit minors' ability to gain access to obscene_matter or materials, as defined by § 22-24-27, or purchase internet connectivity from an internet service provider that provides filter services to limit access to obscene materials; or and
- (2) Develop and implement, by January 1, <u>2001</u> <u>2025</u>, a local policy that establishes measures to restrict minors from <u>computer access to accessing</u> obscene <u>matter or materials</u>. The school board shall:
 - (a) Publish the policy on the school district's website; or
 - (b) Publish the policy annually in the legal newspaper designated by the school board pursuant to § 13-8-10.
