A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for disaster relief requirements for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
- 4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
- 5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2017:

1	DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
2	FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
3	DISASTER RELIEF FUND
4	For an additional amount for "Disaster Relief Fund"
5	for major disasters declared pursuant to the Robert T.
6	Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
7	(42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.), \$7,400,000,000, to remain avail-
8	able until expended: Provided, That such amount is des-
9	ignated by the Congress as being for an emergency re-
10	quirement pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Bal-
11	anced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985:
12	Provided further, That the amount designated under this
13	heading as an emergency requirement pursuant to section
14	251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
15	Deficit Control Act of 1985 shall be available only if the
16	President subsequently so designates such amount and
17	transmits such designation to the Congress.
18	SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION
19	DISASTER LOANS PROGRAM ACCOUNT
20	(INCLUDING TRANSFER OF FUNDS)
21	For an additional amount for the "Disaster Loans
22	Program Account" for the cost of direct loans authorized
23	by section 7(b) of the Small Business Act, \$450,000,000,
24	to remain available until expended: Provided, That up to
25	\$225,000,000 may be transferred to and merged with

- 1 "Salaries and Expenses" for administrative expenses to
- 2 carry out the disaster loan program authorized by section
- 3 7(b) of the Small Business Act: Provided further, That
- 4 none of the funds provided under this heading may be
- 5 used for indirect administrative expenses: Provided fur-
- 6 ther, That the amount provided under this heading is des-
- 7 ignated as an emergency requirement pursuant to section
- 8 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
- 9 Deficit Control Act of 1985: Provided further, That the
- 10 amount designated under this heading as an emergency
- 11 requirement pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the
- 12 Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of
- 13 1985 shall be available only if the President subsequently
- 14 so designates such amount and transmits such designation
- 15 to the Congress.
