- 5 benefits are paid to a claimant during a certain period of unemployment because the
- 6 employing unit shut down due to a natural disaster and the Governor declared a 7 state of emergency due to the natural disaster; providing that the waiver may be in
- 8 effect only for a certain period; and generally relating to the charge of unemployment
- 9 insurance benefits against the earned rating records of employing units.

- 7 (II) THE DATE THE EMPLOYING UNIT REOPENS.
