To amend the Trade Act of 1974 to provide for the automatic exclusion of China as a beneficiary country.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safeguarding Trade
- 5 Opportunities and Preventing China's Anti-Competitive
- 6 Practices Act".
- 7 SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF AUTOMATIC EXCLUSION.
- 8 Section 502 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C.
- 9 2462) is amended in subsection (b)(1) by adding at the
- 10 end the following new subparagraph:

1 "(J) China.".
