- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Restoring American
- 5 Privacy Act of 2017".

1	SEC. 2. PROTECTING THE PRIVACY OF BROADBAND CUS-
2	TOMERS.
3	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a pro-
4	vider of broadband Internet access service (as defined in
5	section 8.2 of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations) shall
6	be subject to—
7	(1) the Report and Order in the matter of pro-
8	tecting the privacy of customers of broadband and
9	other telecommunications services that was adopted
10	by the Federal Communications Commission on Oc-
11	tober 27, 2016 (FCC 16-148); and
12	(2) the rules adopted in such Report and Order.
