A BILL

To enact section 5.261 of the Revised Code to 1
designate May 24 as First Responders' 2
Appreciation Day. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5.261 of the Revised Code be 4
enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 5.261. The twenty-fourth day of May is designated as 6
"First Responders' Appreciation Day" to recognize individuals 7
who risk their own safety on a daily basis in the execution of 8
their duties to protect the public. 9
