A BILL

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 1
4503.4991 of the Revised Code to create the 2
"KylerStrong Foundation" license plate. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 4501.21 be amended and section 4
4503.4991 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows: 5

Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state 6
treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 7
consist of all contributions paid by motor vehicle registrants 8
and collected by the registrar of motor vehicles pursuant to 9
sections 4503.491, 4503.492, 4503.493, 4503.494, 4503.495, 10
4503.496, 4503.498, 4503.499, 4503.4991, 4503.50, 4503.501, 11
4503.502, 4503.505, 4503.51, 4503.522, 4503.523, 4503.524, 12
4503.525, 4503.526, 4503.528, 4503.529, 4503.531, 4503.534, 13
4503.545, 4503.55, 4503.551, 4503.552, 4503.553, 4503.554, 14
4503.555, 4503.561, 4503.562, 4503.564, 4503.565, 4503.576, 15
4503.577, 4503.591, 4503.592, 4503.67, 4503.68, 4503.69, 16
4503.701, 4503.71, 4503.711, 4503.712, 4503.713, 4503.715, 17
4503.72, 4503.73, 4503.732, 4503.74, 4503.75, 4503.751, 18

4503.763, 4503.85, 4503.86, 4503.87, 4503.89, 4503.90, 4503.902, 19
4503.903, 4503.904, 4503.92, 4503.94, and 4503.97 of the Revised 20
Code. 21

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 22
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 23

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 24
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 25
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 26
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 27
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 28
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 29
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 30
other abortion-related activities. 31

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 32
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 33
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 34
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 35
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 36
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 37
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 38
other money in that fund. 39

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 40
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 41
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 42
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 43

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 44
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 45
national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 46
amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 47

chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 48
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 49
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 50
directly to their clients. 51

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 52
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 53
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 54
it receives under this section to assist those who suffer with 55
pancreatic cancer and their families. 56

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 57
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 58
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 59
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 60
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 61

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 62
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 63
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 64
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 65

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 66
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 67
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 68
contributions for its research and other programs. 69

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 70
receives pursuant to section 4503.4991 of the Revised Code to 71
the KylerStrong foundation, which shall use the contributions to 72
raise awareness of brain cancer caused by diffuse intrinsic 73
pontine glioma and to fund research for the cure of such cancer. 74

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 75
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 76

future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 77
contributions into its general account to be used for 78
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 79
America foundation. 80

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 81
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 82
4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 83
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 84
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 85

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 86
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 87
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 88
scholarships and other educational activities. 89

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 90
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 91
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 92
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 93
that organization. 94

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 95
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 96
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 97
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 98
section. A university or college that receives contributions 99
from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 100
scholarship fund. 101

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 102
receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the 103
"friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, 104
incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws 105

of this state, to assist that organization in paying the 106
expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, 107
educational, and cultural events at the monument. 108

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 109
receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the 110
fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for 111
the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the 112
lighthouses of fairport harbor. 113

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 114
receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the 115
Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the 116
contributions only to promote and support the football team of 117
Washington high school of the Massillon city school district. 118

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 119
receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the 120
United States power squadron districts seven, eleven, twenty- 121
four, and twenty-nine in equal amounts. Each power squadron 122
district shall use the money it receives under this section to 123
pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or 124
sponsors within this state. 125

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 126
receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the 127
Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis 128
international, which shall use the money it receives under this 129
section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian 130
activities. 131

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 132
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 133
Ohio association of child caring agencies, which shall use the 134

money it receives under this section to pay the expenses it 135
incurs in advancing its mission of sustainably improving the 136
provision of services to children, young adults, and families in 137
this state. 138

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 139
receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 140
Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 141
receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 142
to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 143
to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 144
their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 145
research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 146
the improvement of patient outcomes. 147

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 148
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 149
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 150
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 151
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 152
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 153
personnel, veterans, and their families. 154

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 155
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 156
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 157
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 158
families. 159

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 160
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 161
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 162
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 163
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 164

hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 165
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 166
destination. 167

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 168
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 169
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 170
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 171
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 172

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 173
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 174
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 175
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 176
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 177
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 178
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 179
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 180
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 181
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 182
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 183

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 184
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 185
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 186

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 187
receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 188
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 189
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 190
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 191
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 192
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 193
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 194

Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 195
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 196
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 197
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 198
under this section. 199

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 200
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 201
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 202
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 203
programs. 204

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 205
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 206
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 207
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 208

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 209
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 210
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 211
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 212
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 213
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 214
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 215
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 216
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 217
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 218
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 219
such payments are to be made. 220

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 221
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 222
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 223
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 224

river watershed. 225

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 226
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to 227
Antioch college for the use of the Glen Helen ecology institute 228
to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen nature preserve. 229

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 230
receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the 231
conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use 232
the money in support of the park. 233

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 234
receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the 235
Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those 236
contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational 237
information about beekeeping, and to support other state and 238
local beekeeping programs. 239

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 240
receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the 241
national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the 242
contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace 243
legends to inspire future leaders. 244

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 245
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 246
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 247
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 248
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 249
commission and that is participating in the license plate 250
program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 251
of the county of residence of an applicant. 252

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each 253

contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of 254
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates 255
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is 256
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 257
(G) of that section. 258

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 259
receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to 260
monarch wings across Ohio, which shall use the contributions for 261
the protection and preservation of the monarch butterfly and 262
pollinator corridor in Ohio and for educational programs. 263

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 264
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 265
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 266
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 267
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 268

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 269
receives pursuant to section 4503.68 of the Revised Code to the 270
great river council of the girl scouts of the United States of 271
America. The council shall distribute all contributions in an 272
equitable manner throughout the state to regional councils of 273
the girl scouts. 274

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 275
receives pursuant to section 4503.69 of the Revised Code to the 276
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 277
shall distribute all contributions in an equitable manner 278
throughout the state to regional councils of the boy scouts. 279

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 280
receives pursuant to section 4503.701 of the Revised Code to the 281
Prince Hall grand lodge of free and accepted masons of Ohio, 282

which shall use the contributions for scholarship purposes. 283

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 284
receives pursuant to section 4503.71 of the Revised Code to the 285
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 286
deposit the fees into its general account to be used for 287
purposes of the fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated. 288

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 289
receives pursuant to section 4503.711 of the Revised Code to the 290
fraternal order of police of Ohio, incorporated, which shall 291
deposit the contributions into an account that it creates to be 292
used for the purpose of advancing and protecting the law 293
enforcement profession, promoting improved law enforcement 294
methods, and teaching respect for law and order. 295

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 296
pursuant to section 4503.712 of the Revised Code to Ohio 297
concerns of police survivors, which shall use those 298
contributions to provide whatever assistance may be appropriate 299
to the families of Ohio law enforcement officers who are killed 300
in the line of duty. 301

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 302
pursuant to section 4503.713 of the Revised Code to the greater 303
Cleveland peace officers memorial society, which shall use those 304
contributions to honor law enforcement officers who have died in 305
the line of duty and support its charitable purposes. 306

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 307
receives pursuant to section 4503.715 of the Revised Code to the 308
fallen linemen organization, which shall use the contributions 309
to recognize and memorialize fallen linemen and support their 310
families. 311

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 312
receives pursuant to section 4503.72 of the Revised Code to the 313
organization known on March 31, 2003, as the Ohio CASA/GAL 314
association, a private, nonprofit corporation organized under 315
Chapter 1702. of the Revised Code. The Ohio CASA/GAL association 316
shall use these contributions to pay the expenses it incurs in 317
administering a program to secure the proper representation in 318
the courts of this state of abused, neglected, and dependent 319
children, and for the training and supervision of persons 320
participating in that program. 321

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 322
receives pursuant to section 4503.73 of the Revised Code to 323
Wright B. Flyer, incorporated, which shall deposit the 324
contributions into its general account to be used for purposes 325
of Wright B. Flyer, incorporated. 326

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 327
receives pursuant to section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to the 328
Siegel & Shuster society, a nonprofit organization dedicated to 329
commemorating and celebrating the creation of Superman in 330
Cleveland, Ohio. 331

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 332
receives pursuant to section 4503.74 of the Revised Code to the 333
Columbus zoological park association, which shall disburse the 334
moneys to Ohio's major metropolitan zoos, as defined in section 335
4503.74 of the Revised Code, in accordance with a written 336
agreement entered into by the major metropolitan zoos. 337

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 338
receives pursuant to section 4503.75 of the Revised Code to the 339
rotary foundation, located on March 31, 2003, in Evanston, 340
Illinois, to be placed in a fund known as the permanent fund and 341

used to endow educational and humanitarian programs of the 342
rotary foundation. 343

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 344
receives pursuant to section 4503.751 of the Revised Code to the 345
Ohio association of realtors, which shall deposit the 346
contributions into a property disaster relief fund maintained 347
under the Ohio realtors charitable and education foundation. 348

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 349
receives pursuant to section 4503.763 of the Revised Code to the 350
Ohio history connection to be used solely to build, support, and 351
maintain the Ohio battleflag collection within the Ohio history 352
connection. 353

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 354
receives pursuant to section 4503.85 of the Revised Code to the 355
Ohio sea grant college program to be used for Lake Erie area 356
research projects. 357

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 358
receives pursuant to section 4503.86 of the Revised Code to the 359
Ohio Lincoln highway historic byway, which shall use those 360
contributions solely to promote and support the historical 361
preservation and advertisement of the Lincoln highway in this 362
state. 363

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 364
receives pursuant to section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to the 365
Grove City little league dream field fund, which shall use those 366
contributions solely to build, maintain, and improve youth 367
baseball fields within the municipal corporation of Grove City. 368

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 369
receives pursuant to section 4503.89 of the Revised Code to the 370

American red cross of greater Columbus on behalf of the Ohio 371
chapters of the American red cross, which shall use the 372
contributions for disaster readiness, preparedness, and response 373
programs on a statewide basis. 374

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 375
receives pursuant to section 4503.90 of the Revised Code to the 376
nationwide children's hospital foundation. 377

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 378
receives pursuant to section 4503.902 of the Revised Code to St. 379
Ignatius high school located in the municipal corporation of 380
Cleveland. The school shall use fifty per cent of the 381
contributions it receives to provide tuition assistance to its 382
students. The school shall use the remaining fifty per cent to 383
pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school's 384
students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and 385
emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may 386
include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving 387
techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and 388
education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug 389
abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. As a part of 390
providing such services, the school may pay for members of the 391
faculty of the school to receive training in providing those 392
services. The school principal or, in the school principal's 393
discretion, appropriate school counselors shall determine any 394
charitable organizations that the school hires to provide those 395
services. The school shall ensure that any such charitable 396
organization is exempt from federal income taxation under 397
subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school 398
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 399
purpose. 400

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.903 of the Revised Code to the Brecksville-Broadview Heights city school district. The school district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. The school district superintendent or, in the school district superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable organizations that the school district hires to provide those services. The school district also may use the contributions it receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school district to receive training in providing such services to the students of the school district. The school district shall ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district shall not use the contributions it receives for any other purpose.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.904 of the Revised Code to the Chagrin Falls exempted village school district. The school district shall use the contributions it receives to pay the expenses it incurs in providing services to the school district's students that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students. The services

provided may include bereavement counseling, instruction in 432
defensive driving techniques, sensitivity training, and the 433
counseling and education of students regarding bullying, dating 434
violence, drug abuse, suicide prevention, and human trafficking. 435
The school district superintendent or, in the school district 436
superintendent's discretion, the appropriate school principal or 437
appropriate school counselors shall determine any charitable 438
organizations that the school district hires to provide those 439
services. The school district also may use the contributions it 440
receives to pay for members of the faculty of the school 441
district to receive training in providing such services to the 442
students of the school district. The school district shall 443
ensure that any charitable organization that is hired by the 444
district is exempt from federal income taxation under subsection 445
501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The school district 446
shall not use the contributions it receives for any other 447
purpose. 448

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 449
pursuant to section 4503.92 of the Revised Code to support our 450
troops, incorporated, a national nonprofit corporation, which 451
shall use those contributions in accordance with its articles of 452
incorporation and for the benefit of servicemembers of the armed 453
forces of the United States and their families when they are in 454
financial need. 455

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 456
receives pursuant to section 4503.94 of the Revised Code to the 457
Michelle's leading star foundation, which shall use the money 458
solely to fund the rental, lease, or purchase of the simulated 459
driving curriculum of the Michelle's leading star foundation by 460
boards of education of city, exempted village, local, and joint 461
vocational school districts. 462

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.97 of the Revised Code to the friends of united Hatzalah of Israel, which shall use the money to support united Hatzalah of Israel, which provides free emergency medical first response throughout Israel.

(C) All investment earnings of the license plate contribution fund shall be credited to the fund. Not later than the first day of May of every year, the registrar shall distribute to each entity described in division (B) of this section the investment income the fund earned the previous calendar year. The amount of such a distribution paid to an entity shall be proportionate to the amount of money the entity received from the fund during the previous calendar year.

Sec. 4503.4991. (A) The owner or lessee of any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle of a class approved by the registrar of motor vehicles may apply to the registrar for the registration of the vehicle and issuance of "KylerStrong Foundation" license plates. An application made under this section may be combined with a request for a special reserved license plate under section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code. Upon receipt of the completed application and compliance by the applicant with divisions (B) and (C) of this section, the registrar shall issue to the applicant the appropriate vehicle registration and a set of "KylerStrong Foundation" license plates and a validation sticker, or a validation sticker alone when required by section 4503.191 of the Revised Code.

In addition to the letters and numbers ordinarily inscribed on the license plates, "KylerStrong Foundation" license plates shall be inscribed with identifying words or

markings that are designed by the KylerStrong foundation and 493
that are approved by the registrar. "KylerStrong Foundation" 494
license plates shall display county identification stickers that 495
identify the county of registration as required under section 496
4503.19 of the Revised Code. 497

(B) "KylerStrong Foundation" license plates and a 498
validation sticker, or validation sticker alone, shall be issued 499
upon receipt of a contribution as provided in division (C)(1) of 500
this section and upon payment of the regular license tax as 501
prescribed under section 4503.04 of the Revised Code, any 502
applicable motor vehicle license tax levied under Chapter 4504. 503
of the Revised Code, any applicable additional fee prescribed by 504
section 4503.40 or 4503.42 of the Revised Code, a bureau of 505
motor vehicles administrative fee of ten dollars, and compliance 506
with all other applicable laws relating to the registration of 507
motor vehicles. 508

(C)(1) For each application for registration and 509
registration renewal notice the registrar receives under this 510
section, the registrar shall collect a contribution of fifteen 511
dollars. The registrar shall transmit this contribution into the 512
state treasury to the credit of the license plate contribution 513
fund created in section 4501.21 of the Revised Code. 514

(2) The registrar shall deposit the bureau administrative 515
fee of ten dollars, the purpose of which is to compensate the 516
bureau for additional services required in the issuing of 517
"KylerStrong Foundation" license plates, into the state treasury 518
to the credit of the state bureau of motor vehicles fund created 519
in section 4501.25 of the Revised Code. 520

Section 2. That existing section 4501.21 of the Revised 521
Code is hereby repealed. 522
