- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthening Disaster
- 5 Assistance for Student Veterans Act of 2019".

20	(A) by striking "solely" and inserting
21	"Solely"; and
22	(B) by striking "during periods" and in-
