AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ACQUIRE AND RESTORE THE HISTORIC
CORNELIUS HIGH SCHOOL AGRICULTURE BUILDING TO SERVE AS A HISTORY
MUSEUM IN THE TOWN OF CORNELIUS.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2023-2024 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to the Town of Cornelius for the acquisition and restoration of the historic 1930s-era Cornelius High School Agriculture Building to serve as a Cornelius history museum that will educate the community by presenting historical artifacts and information significant to the town, region, and State.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
