CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Schools – Student Telehealth Appointments – Policy and Access**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to establish a policy to
4 accommodate students who need to participate in telehealth appointments during
5 the school day; requiring each public middle and high school to designate a space
6 that meets certain requirements for student telehealth appointments; and generally
7 relating to student access to telehealth in schools.

10 Section 4–142

11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Education**

16 **4–142.**

17 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “TELEHEALTH” MEANS A MODE OF DELIVERING**
18 **HEALTH CARE SERVICES THROUGH THE USE OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

Underlining indicates amendments to bill.

1 TECHNOLOGIES BY A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER TO A PATIENT AT A DIFFERENT
2 PHYSICAL LOCATION THAN THE HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER.

3 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH A POLICY TO ACCOMMODATE
4 STUDENTS WHO NEED TO PARTICIPATE IN TELEHEALTH APPOINTMENTS
5 SCHEDULED DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.

6 (C) THE POLICY ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION
7 SHALL REQUIRE EACH MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL TO:

8 (1) DESIGNATE A SPACE FOR STUDENT TELEHEALTH APPOINTMENTS
9 THAT:

10 (I) IS A PRIVATE SPACE IN THE SCHOOL;

11 (II) HAS INTERNET ACCESS;

12 (III) INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE SEATING OPTION WITH A FLAT
13 SURFACE AND ELECTRICAL OUTLET NEARBY TO ACCOMMODATE PLACEMENT OF A
14 LAPTOP DEVICE; AND

15 (IV) IS NOT A BATHROOM OR CLOSET; AND

16 (2) IMPLEMENT MEASURES TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND PRIVACY OF
17 A STUDENT PARTICIPATING IN A TELEHEALTH APPOINTMENT.

18 (D) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT THE LOCAL SCHOOL
19 SYSTEM:

20 (1) PUBLISHES THE STUDENT TELEHEALTH POLICY IN THE STUDENT
21 HANDBOOK; AND

22 (2) MAKES SCHOOL PERSONNEL AWARE OF STUDENT TELEHEALTH
23 POLICY OBJECTIVES AND REQUIREMENTS.

24 (E) ON REQUEST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE TECHNICAL
25 ASSISTANCE TO A COUNTY BOARD TO ESTABLISH THE STUDENT TELEHEALTH
26 POLICY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

27 (F) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO ~~REQUIRE~~:

28 (1) REQUIRE A SCHOOL TO CONSTRUCT AN ADDITION OR A NEW
29 SPACE TO A SCHOOL BUILDING TO PROVIDE A PRIVATE SPACE TO COMPLY WITH THE
30 STUDENT TELEHEALTH POLICY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; OR

1 **(2) ALTER THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER**
2 **REGARDING THE DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL RECORDS UNDER TITLE 4, SUBTITLE 3**
3 **OF THE HEALTH – GENERAL ARTICLE, INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY TO DISCLOSE A**
4 **MEDICAL RECORD IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2024.
