A BILL

To prohibit the owner or operator of a port in the United States to enter into a contract with certain entities for operation or management of such port.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Secure Our Ports Act
- 5 of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN CONTRACTS FOR PORT
2	OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT.
3	An owner or operator of a port in the United States
4	may not enter into a contract for the operation or manage-
5	ment of such port with an entity that is—
6	(1) a Chinese, Russian, North Korean, or Ira-
7	nian state-owned enterprise; or
8	(2) any foreign entity for which any percentage
9	is owned by a country listed in paragraph (1).
