A BILL

To amend the Civil Rights Cold Case Records Collection Act of 2018 to extend the termination date of the Civil Rights Cold Case Records Review Board.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Civil Rights Cold Case
5 Investigations Support Act of 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. CIVIL RIGHTS COLD CASE RECORDS REVIEW**
2 **BOARD EXTENSION OF TENURE.**

3 Section 5(n)(1) of Civil Rights Cold Case Records
4 Collection Act of 2018 (44 U.S.C. 2107 note; Public Law
5 115–426) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “4 years” and inserting “7
7 years”; and

8 (2) by striking “4-year period” and inserting
9 “7-year period”.

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
