A BILL

To prohibit arms sales to Turkey.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON ARMS SALES TO TURKEY.
- 4 Beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act,
- 5 the United States Government may not sell, transfer, de-
- 6 liver, license for export, authorize the performance of any
- 7 service relating to, or otherwise make available any de-
- 8 fense article, defense service, or design and construction
- 9 service, as such terms are defined for purposes of the
- 10 Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2751 et seq.), to the

- 1 Government of Turkey or to any agents or instrumental-
- 2 ities of such Government.
