A BILL

To amend section 6428A of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to increase recovery rebate amounts to \$2,000 for individuals.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Caring for Americans
- 5 with Supplemental Help Act of 2020" or the "CASH Act
- 6 of 2020".

1 SEC. 2. RECOVERY REBATE AMOUNTS INCREASED.

- 2 (a) In General.—Section 6428A of the Internal
- Revenue Code of 1986, as added by section 272 of the
- 4 COVID-related Tax Relief Act of 2020, is amended by
- 5 striking "\$600" each place it appears and inserting
- 6 "\$2,000", and by striking "\$1,200" each place it appears
- 7 and inserting "\$4,000".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 9 this section are contingent upon the enactment of the
- 10 COVID-related Tax Relief Act of 2020 and shall apply
- 11 (if at all) as if included in the enactment of section 272
- 12 of such Act.

13 SEC. 3. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 14 (a) STATUTORY PAYGO SCORECARDS.—The budg-
- 15 etary effects of this Act shall not be entered on either
- 16 PAYGO scorecard maintained pursuant to section 4(d) of
- 17 the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010.
- 18 (b) Senate PAYGO Scorecards.—The budgetary
- 19 effects of this Act shall not be entered on any PAYGO
- 20 scorecard maintained for purposes of section 4106 of H.
- 21 Con. Res. 71 (115th Congress).
