## A BILL

To amend subtitle A of title XX of the Social Security Act to fund additional projects that focus on competencybased training for personal or home care aides, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Mollie Baldwin
- 5 Upskilling of Personal and Home Care Aides Act".

1	SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
2	PROFESSIONS WORKFORCE PROJECTS.
3	Section 2008 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
4	1397g) is amended by adding at the end the following new
5	subsection:
6	"(e) Expansion of Health and Human Services
7	Professions Workforce Projects.—
8	"(1) AUTHORITY TO AWARD GRANTS.—The
9	Secretary, in consultation with the Secretary of
10	Labor, shall award grants to eligible entities to con-
11	duct projects—
12	"(A) that employ upskilling training mod-
13	els that focus on competency-based training
14	for—
15	"(i) personal or home care aides (as
16	defined in subsection (b));
17	"(ii) direct support professionals;
18	"(iii) home health aides; and
19	"(iv) nursing assistants;
20	"(B) that are designed to provide eligible
21	individuals with the opportunity to obtain edu-
22	cation and training for positions as personal or
23	home care aides (as so defined), direct support
24	professionals, home health aides, or nursing as-
25	sistants that pay a living wage and are expected

1	to either experience labor shortages or be in
2	high demand; and
3	"(C) for which grants were awarded under
4	subsection (a).
5	"(2) Selection of Projects.—
6	"(A) Requirements for eligible enti-
7	TIES.—An eligible entity seeking to receive a
8	grant under this subsection to conduct a project
9	shall demonstrate—
10	"(i) that the eligible entity has suc-
11	cessfully conducted the project in the past
12	and
13	"(ii) that the project implements the
14	core training competencies for personal or
15	home care aides described in subsection
16	(b)(3)(A).
17	"(B) Priority for rural areas and
18	UNDERSERVED URBAN AREAS.—
19	"(i) In General.—In awarding
20	grants under this subsection, the Secretary
21	shall give priority to projects that sup-
22	port—
23	"(I) rural areas (as defined in
24	section $2007(f)$ : or

1	"(II) underserved urban areas
2	(including urban health professional
3	shortage areas (as defined in section
4	332 of the Public Health Service
5	Act)).
6	"(ii) Threshold for prioritized
7	PROJECTS.—In awarding grants under this
8	subsection, the Secretary shall ensure that
9	not less than 50 percent of the grants
0	awarded under this subsection shall be for
1	projects described in clause (i).
2	"(3) Reports and evaluation.—
3	"(A) ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.—An eligible en-
4	tity awarded a grant to expand a project under
5	this subsection shall submit interim reports to
6	the Secretary on the activities carried out under
7	the project and a final report on such activities
8	upon the conclusion of the entities' participa-
9	tion in the project.
20	"(B) EVALUATION.—The Secretary shall,
21	by grant, contract, or interagency agreement,
22	evaluate the projects conducted under this sub-
23	section. Such evaluation shall include identifica-
24	tion of successful activities for creating oppor-

tunities for developing and sustaining, particu-

larly with respect to low-income individuals and other entry-level workers, a health and human services professions workforce that has accessible entry points, that meets high standards for education, training, certification, and professional development, that provides increased wages and affordable benefits, including health care coverage, that are responsive to the workforce's needs, and that is responsive to the needs of diverse racial and ethnic communities.

- "(C) Report to congress.—The Secretary shall submit interim reports and, based on the evaluation conducted under subparagraph (B), a final report to Congress on the projects conducted under this subsection.
- "(4) DEFINITIONS.—Any term used in this subsection that is also used in subsection (a) shall have the same meaning for purposes of this subsection as such term has in such subsection (a).
- "(5) Funding.—Out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there are appropriated to the Secretary to carry out this subsection \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2022 through 2032.".
