19	Section 1. Section 76-3-203.19 is enacted to read:
20	76-3-203.19. Aggravating factor for an assault or threat of violence committed
21	against a referee.
22	(1) As used in this section:
23	(a) "Assault" means an offense under Section 76-5-102.
24	(b)(i) "Referee" means an individual who is officiating, with or without
25	compensation, a sporting event or match sanctioned and formally organized by a
26	public or private organization, league, school, institution, or other entity.
27	(ii) "Referee" does not include an individual who is officiating an informal,
28	unsanctioned sporting event or match.
29	(c) "Threat of violence" means an offense under Section 76-5-107.

(2) For a defendant convicted of assault or threat of violence, it is an aggravating factor if

31	the sentencing court finds that the defendant committed the offense against a referee
32	while the referee was acting within the scope of the referee's official duties.
33	(3) When sentencing a defendant convicted of assault or threat of violence subject to the
34	aggravating factor described in Subsection (2), the sentencing court shall consider the
35	aggravating factor.
36	Section 2. Effective Date.
