22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FORGED DIGITAL LIKENESS" HAS THE MEANING 23 STATED IN § 8-906 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
 4 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
 5 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 6 (E) IT IS AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE TO A PROSECUTION UNDER THIS
 7 SECTION THAT THE DEFENDANT TOOK REASONABLE ACTION TO PLACE VIEWERS OR
 8 LISTENERS OF THE FORGED DIGITAL LIKENESS ON NOTICE THAT THE FORGED
 9 DIGITAL LIKENESS WAS NOT GENUINE.
- 10 (F) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED IN A MANNER THAT INFRINGES
 11 ON THE RIGHT TO FREE SPEECH OR OF THE PRESS AS GUARANTEED BY THE FIRST
 12 AMENDMENT OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION OR THE MARYLAND
 13 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
