

- 1 (2) The Governor shall give a member who is charged a copy of the charges 2 against the member and, with at least 10 days' notice, an opportunity to be heard publicly 3 in person or by counsel.
- 4 (3) If a member is removed, the Governor shall file with the Office of the Secretary of State a statement of charges against the member and the Governor's findings on the charges.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members serving on the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County on the effective date of this Act shall expire at the end of June 30, 2017.
