A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to implement, administer, or enforce the Executive order entitled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States" signed by President Donald J. Trump on January 27, 2017.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This Act may be cited as the "No Funds for Uncon-4 stitutional Executive Orders Act". SEC. 2. FINDINGS. 6 7 Congress finds the following: 8 (1) The first 10 words of the Bill of Rights 9 state: "Congress shall make no law respecting an es-10 tablishment of religion". 11 (2) In Larson v. Valente, the Supreme Court 12 stated: "The clearest command of the Establishment 13 Clause is that one religious denomination cannot be 14 officially preferred over another.". 15 (3) On January 27, 2017, President Donald J. 16 Trump signed into force an Executive order impos-17 ing a selective ban on immigration from majority-18 Muslim nations. 19 (4) On January 27, 2017, President Trump 20 signed into force an Executive order that permits 21 the Secretaries of State and Homeland Security to 22 admit individuals to the United States as refugees if 23 they are a religious minority in their home nation,

because that is in the "national interest".

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- 1 (5) On January 27, 2017, the Christian Broad-2 casting Network published an interview between 3 David Brody and President Trump entitled Brody 4 File Exclusive: President Trump Says Persecuted 5 Christians Will Be Given Priority As Refugees in 6 which President Trump says persecuted Christians 7 will be given priority for admission to the United 8 States over other religions.
- 9 (6) The Executive order entitled "Protecting 10 the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the 11 United States" authored and signed by President 12 Trump violates the Establishment Clause of the 13 United States Constitution.

14 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION.

No funds, resources, or fees made available by the United States Congress to any Federal agency may be used to implement, administer, enforce, or carry out (in- luding through the issuance of any regulations) any of the policy changes set forth in the Executive order titled "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States" signed by President Donald J. Trump on January 27, 2017.
